7 children will be vulnerable in 1 or more developmental areas

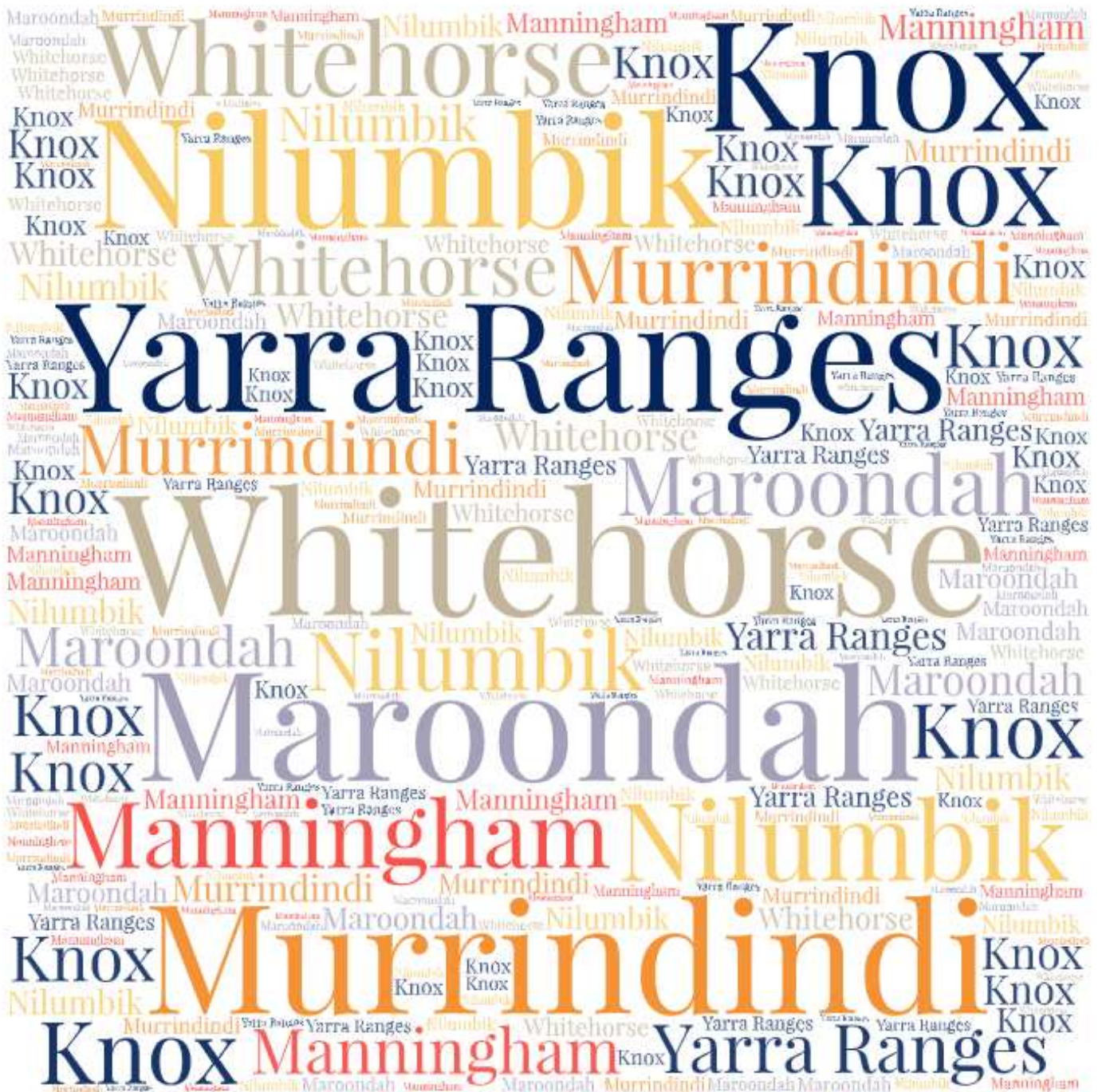
30% of residents were **born overseas**
